

Psalm 139 (Elementary)

1. Start with a Question

- What does it mean when someone really knows you?
 - How does it feel to know God always sees you and understands you?

2. Read Psalm 139 Together (from your Bible or use this kid-friendly version)

God, you know me so well.

You know when I sit and when I stand.

You know everything I am thinking before I even say it.

Wherever I go, you are there.

If I go up to the heavens, you are there.

If I go down to the depths, you are there too.

Even in the darkness, nothing is hidden from you.

You created every part of me.

I praise you because I am wonderfully made.

Everything you do is amazing.

3. Talk About It

- How does it feel to know that God sees everything about you and loves you?
 - Can you think of a time when it helps to remember God is with you?
 - What is one thing that makes you “wonderfully made”?

5. Activity: “Wonderfully Made” Picture

- Have your child draw or write:
 - Something they love about themselves
 - A time they felt God was with them
 - Write the memory verse at the bottom:
“I praise you because I am wonderfully made.” — Psalm 139:14
